Join us in November to hear Reggie Littlejohn and Ryan Bomberger present their latest initiatives, which are hitting the headlines in the US and putting abortion advocates on the defensive. Professor William Binchy, Legal Adviser to the Pro Life Campaign, will also review current pressures to legalise abortion and the destruction of human embryos in Ireland.



Ryan Bomberger founded the Radiance Foundation in the US, and launched the hugely successful Too Many Aborted billboard and multi-media campaign. It highlights how African Americans are specifically targeted by the abortion industry and have disproportionately high numbers of abortions. Ryan's biological mother was raped and he was adopted and grew up in a loving multi-racial family.



Reggie Littlejohn founded Women's Rights Without Frontiers, an organisation dedicated to raising public awareness of the human rights abuses involved in China's one-child policy. She has testified on the issue before the US Congress, briefed the White House and the European and British Parliaments. As a prominent lawyer, she has also represented Chinese refugees in political asylum cases in the United States.
